The Charlottetown Chito Ryu Karate Club has enjoyed a 35-year history of classes at St. Jean's Elementary School. The gymnasium facility has served us well over that time. We have an opportunity to move to another location as the sole tenant in a new, permanent facility at the Holland College West Royalty & Sport PEI building on January 1, 2006.

Students

The new dojo will be accessible seven days a week. While continuing the same training programs that are currently offered, the new dojo provides additional time for: specialized training that will benefit all students; specialized programs in kumite, kata, bo, etc; and specialized classes especially for seniors or adults.

Fund-raising

This pending move marks a new chapter in the history of Chito Ryu in Charlottetown. The current condition of the new location will require manpower and resources to create a dojo suitable to our needs. It is a large room with a cement floor, high ceilings and good lighting.
